On a docent-guided tour, you will discover two sumptuous works by Anne Vallayer-Coster, encounter Gustave Caillebotte's thickly painted yellow roses, and contemplate a flower-filled canvas painted by Georgia O'Keeffe. *From Lilies to Lilacs* features these works and many more. See flowers from all seasons in works of art spanning two centuries, learn about the works, and consider the creative choices made by the artists.
