### Dallas Museum of Art – Exhibition Catalogs Online (DMA-ECO)

DMA-ECO focuses on digitization of DMA published exhibition catalogs and related material dated between 1903 and 1983. The Archives Department opted to work with the University of North Texas's [Digital Projects Unit](#) to assist with the digitization of published material. The Digital Projects Unit also operates the [Portal to Texas History](#), and when the digitization is completed, the exhibition catalogs will also be available through the Portal, increasing visibility for the material. Additional digitization of related material, such as unpublished checklists, press releases, invitations and entry forms, is being done in-house; this material will also be available through the Portal. Scanning will be complete soon. Activities through the end of the project in September 2012 include cataloging and upload of materials to both the DMA website and Portal to Texas History.

### Dallas Museum of Art – Access to Archival Exhibition Resources Online (AAERO)

The AAERO project grant will fund the creation of a web-based template for public presentation of materials relating to an exhibition. It will function as a portal to exhibition content stored in a variety of virtual locations. Everything from exhibition descriptions, checklists, label copy, selected object images, publications, installation photography, audio and video recordings of related lectures and programs, and press and marketing materials will be available. The template will initially be populated with resources already in digital format from exhibitions held since 2003; and exhibition catalogs and related material digitized through the DMA-ECO project. The AAERO project will also fund the Spanish translation of brochures from the DMA's *Concentrations* series of contemporary art exhibitions and excerpts from selected artist lectures.
